- ☐ Are often understated






Why perceptions

The result was improved river corridor


England, UK: urban river corridor (Holt et al, 2012)

□Results: heathy living city with recreational activities



LITERATURE


- ✓ Capacity of the ecosystem services to deliver services to people.
